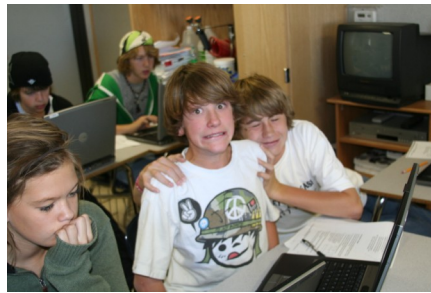
GREAT NEWS! THE MVHS CHARTER WAS APPROVED BY THE CIMARRON SCHOOL BOARD.

2011 marks the year with one of the largest 9th grade classes MVHS has ever had. Adjustment to schedules, lockers and homework has been interesting. We can make it work!





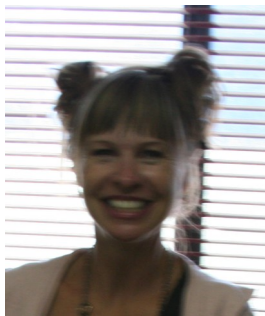
MVHS Rotary Interact Club
